# NME Melaleuca ericifolia swamp forest

### **Community Description:**

Melaleuca ericifolia swamp forest typically occurs as pure or almost pure stands of Melaleuca ericifolia with trees generally 10 – 12 m in height (but reaching 20 m) forming a dense canopy. The understorey is generally simple and devoid of shrubs due to low light levels and/or frequent flooding. It is most often dominated by Carex appressa and/or Gahnia grandis and Blechnum wattsii and Lepidosperma elatius may be present. This is the appropriate benchmark to use in assessing the condition of the listed Melaleuca ericifolia swamp forest community (Schedule 3A, Nature Conservation Act 2002).
